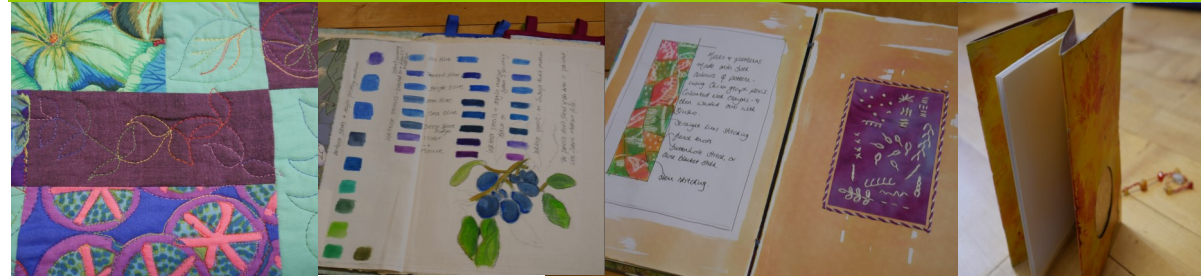


Tamzin really enjoys making creative sketchbooks to help explore techniques, and methods in her textile designs.

Requirements

You will need:

A3 Pink Pig sketch book, acrylic paints, brushes, craft knife, glue stick, erasers, fabric, brayer, flat tile, apron, found papers and cardboard. Later, you will need access to a sewing machine.

Where and when

At In Stitches, 22 Westwood Road, GL5 4JQ

Tuesdays 10am - midday. Starting 31st March 2020

Costs £90 for the 6 week course (materials not included)

You will try mono printing, carved print blocks, texture rubbings, cord making, machine quilting and a selection of book making methods.

You will gather your ideas into a sketchbook and will develop your ideas to make a unique sketchbook cover.
